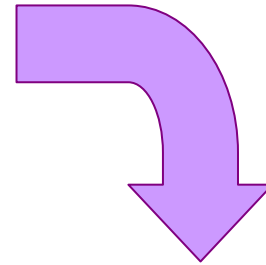

# Organize the Wasted Spaces of Your Home

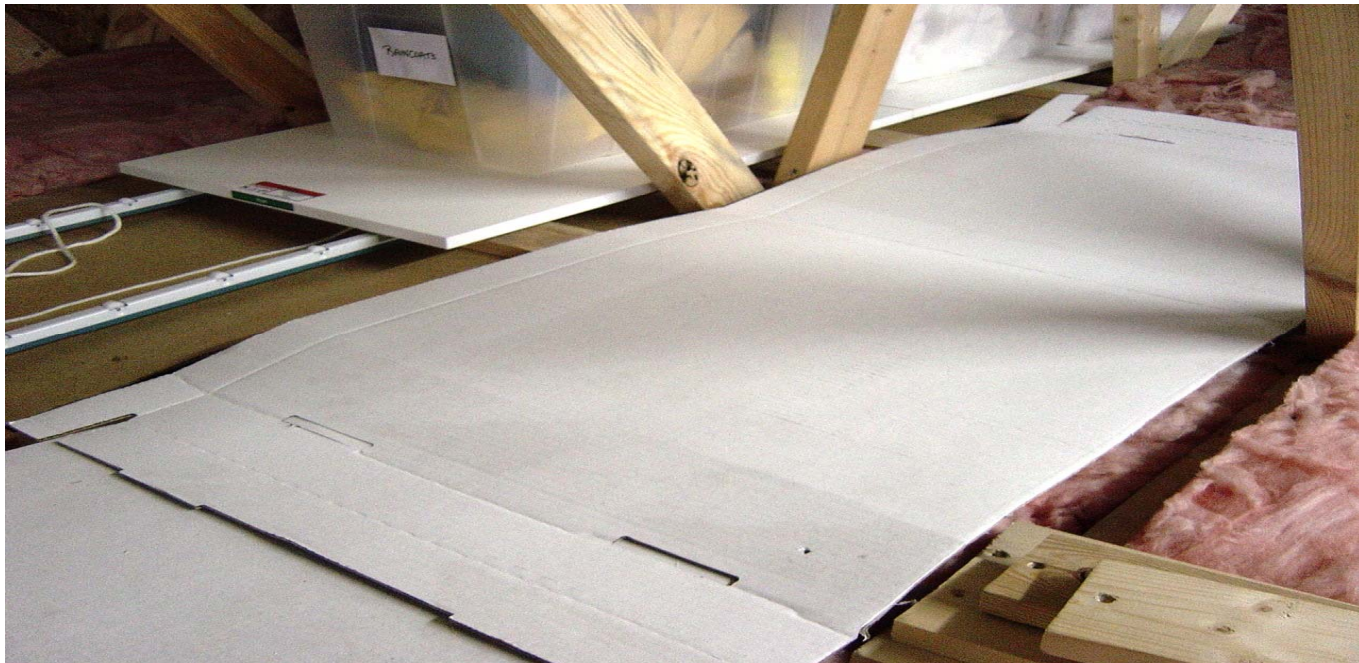


# What You Should Do



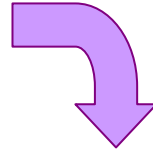
**Verify that there is a clear path for the installation of Attic Trac plus and take measurements for maximum future organizational uses.**

**First lay a portion of the carton over the insulation to protect you from feeling the itch of fiberglass when you use Attic Trac plus**



There will be a minimum impact of the effectiveness of the insulation in protecting you from fiberglass or cellulose insulation by using Attic Trac plus

**Next install the rail supports that will hold the rails in place**



**All rails are now connected to form the track system for the platforms**



**The back platform should have a cable latch attached to give you flexibility in the use of Attic Trac plus in the future.**



**Once all platforms are in place, you are ready to complete the final organization of your attic in each row. It is recommended that you place all you Holiday items at the front of the attic opening for quick access.**



*Recommendation: A row for Holiday, a row for frequent items, and a row for seldom used items*





# Attic Trac Operation



**Pull items to opening**

**Slip finger into cable ring  
and pull all items toward  
you**



**Move items to back of attic**

**Take your thumb or finger  
and gently push on the  
green "Push" label**

**You can now discover your new  
Organizational Space within your Attic**
